Storm hydrographs for two drainage basins

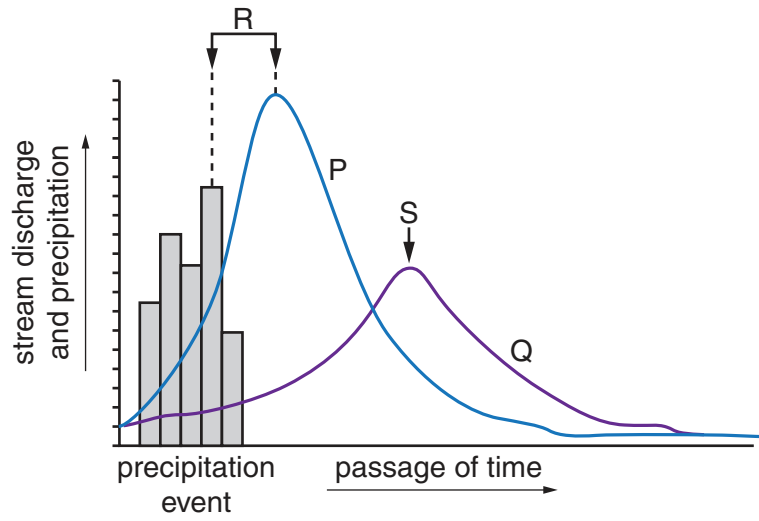

Precipitation pathways in two drainage basins

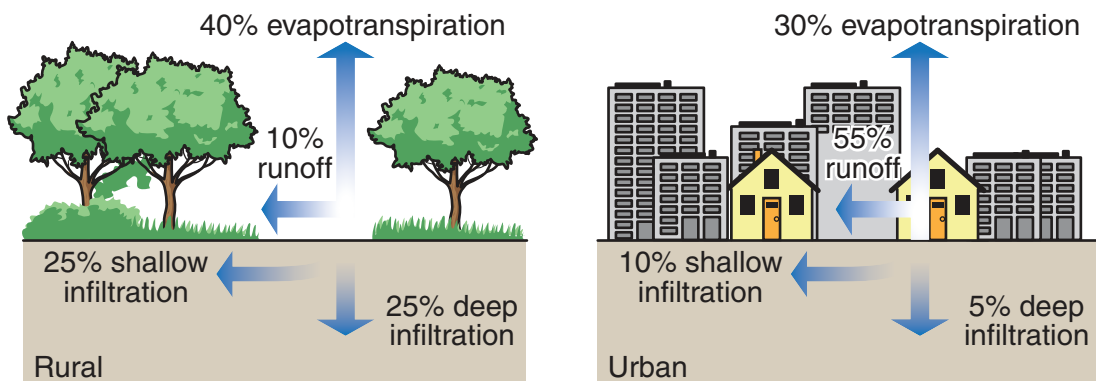

The Earth's radiation balance for one year

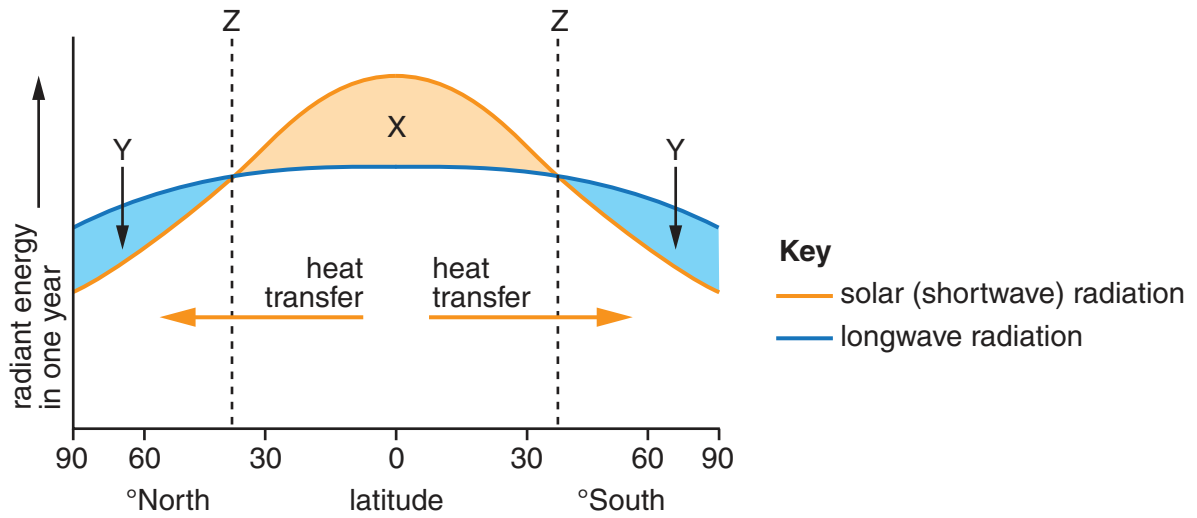

A model of atmospheric circulation

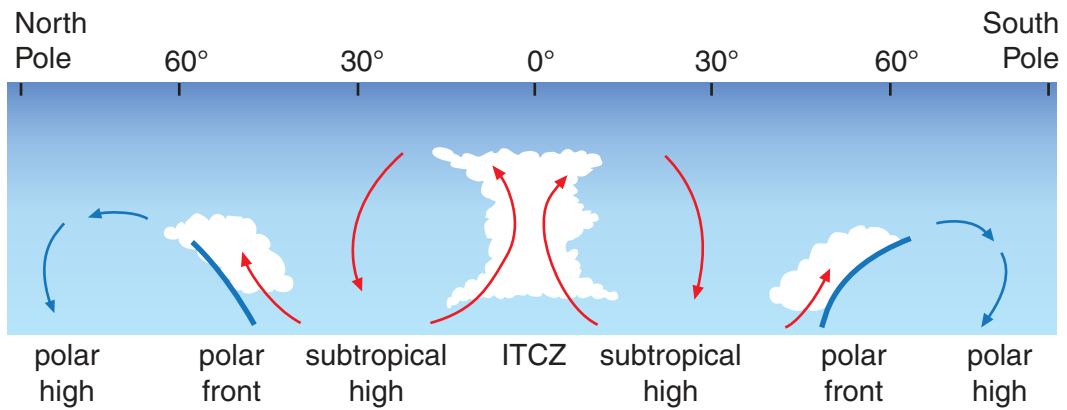

The relationship between moisture conditions, speed and the type of mass movement

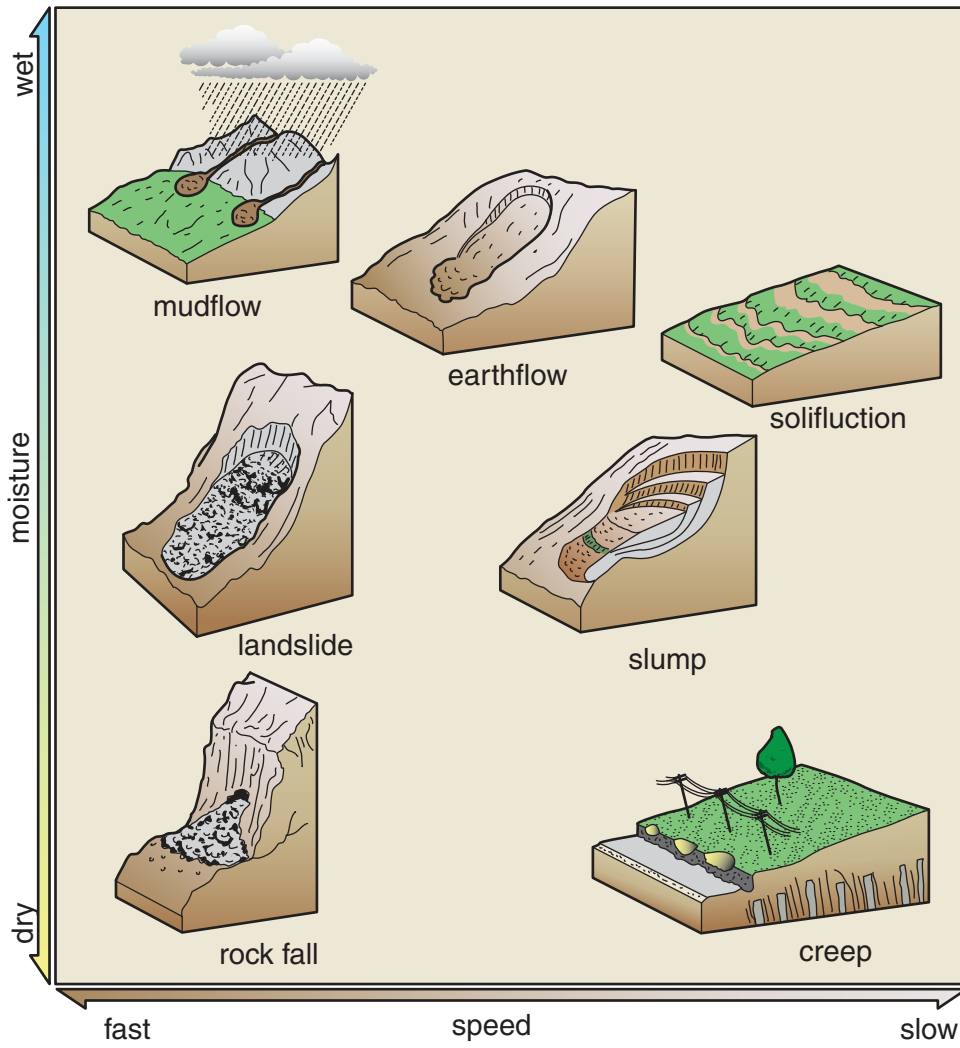

A model of the relationship between population and resources

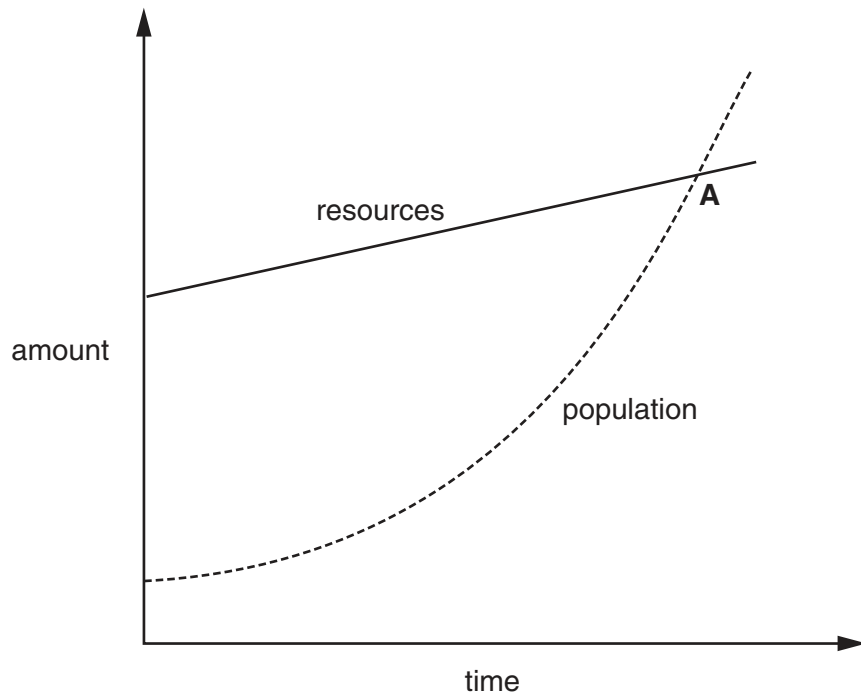

Main destinations of refugees from Somalia, 2010

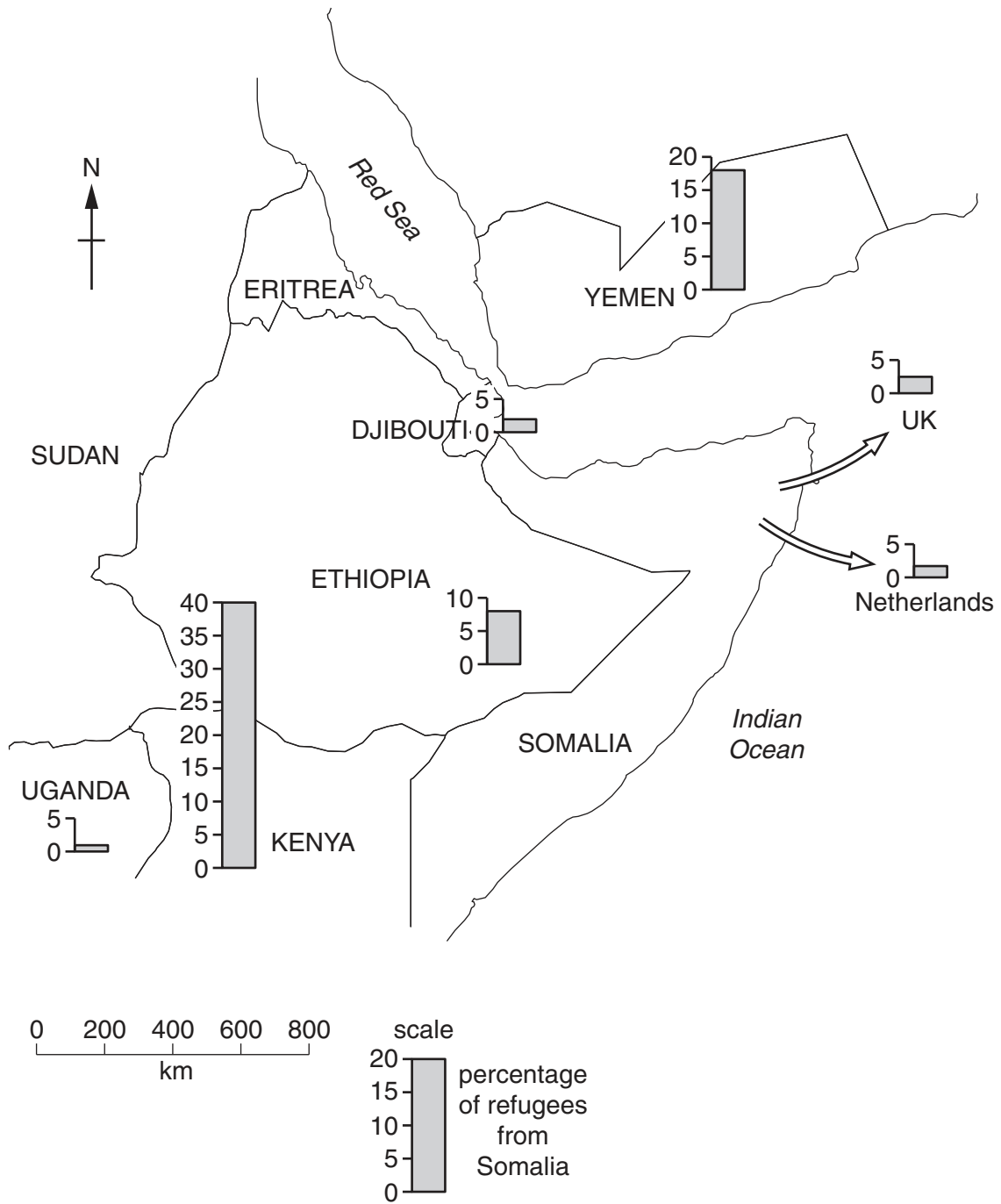
