Position of the ITCZ and the mean pattern of winds in January and July

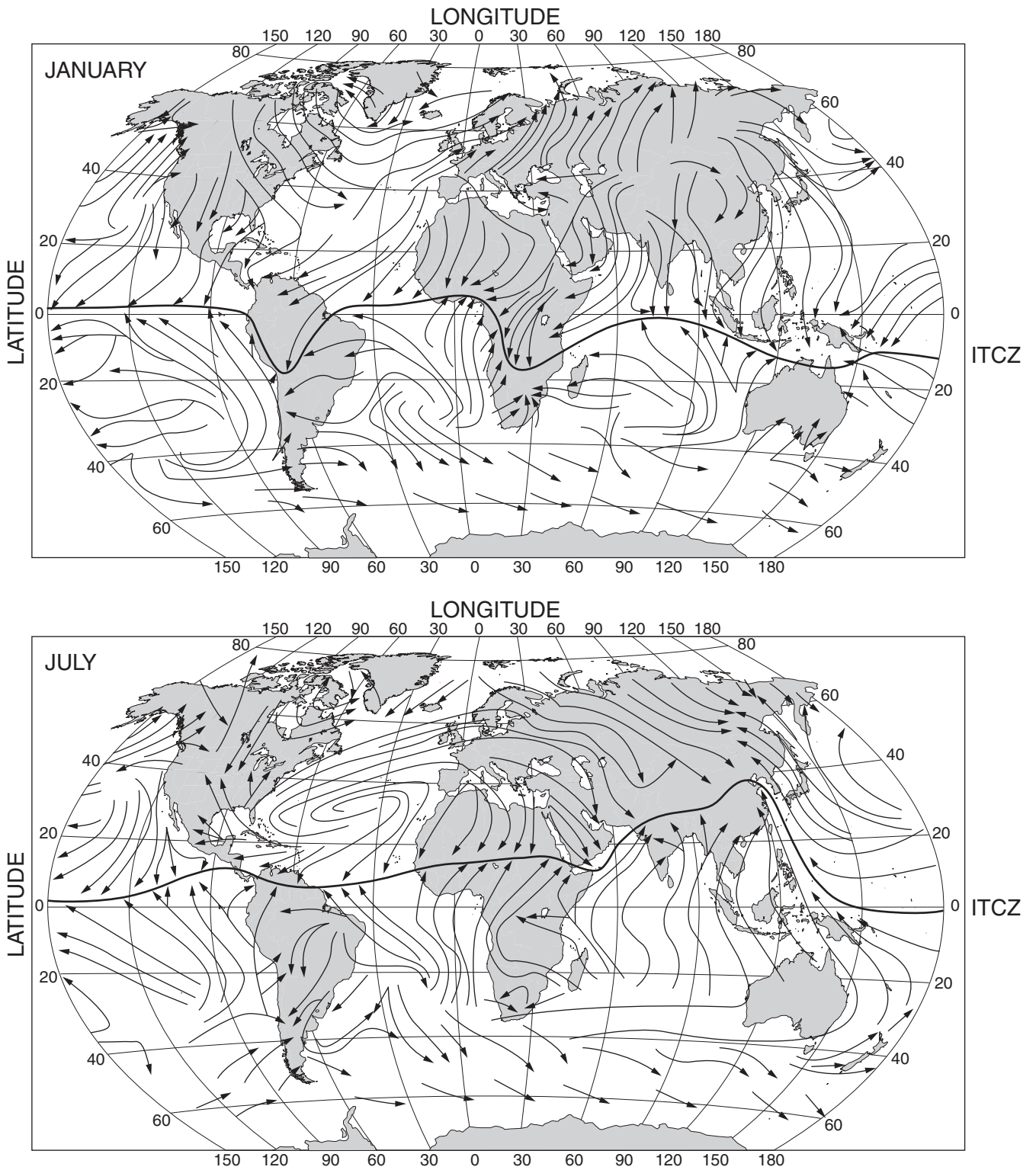

Cross section of a beach – dune – saltmarsh complex

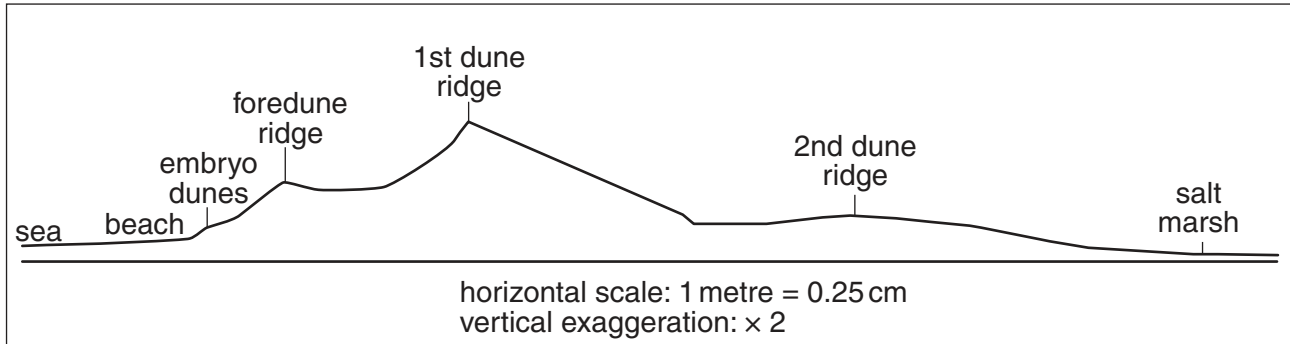

A classification of tsunami in the Pacific Ocean

Intensity	Height of wave at coast (metres)	Description	Estimated frequency
1	0.5	Very slight wave, only measurable by instruments.	1 every 4 months
2	1	Slight wave noticeable on flat shores.	1 every 4 months
3	2	Large wave noticed by population. Some flooding and damage.	1 every 8 months
4	8	Very large wave. General flooding. Damage to harbours and quays, light buildings destroyed. People drowned.	1 every 3 years
5	16	Huge waves, destruction of all types of coastal buildings. Flooding to great depths and distances. Damage to large ships. Many deaths.	1 every 10 years
