an HIC in Europe, 2012–17

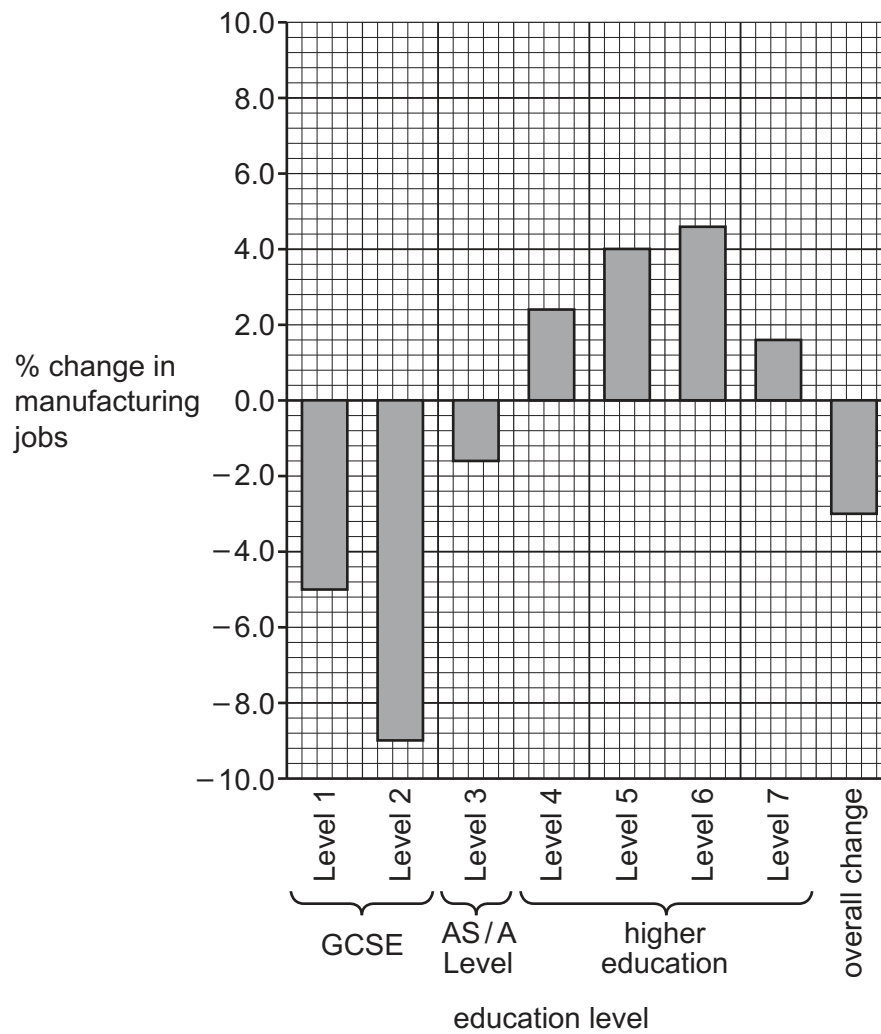
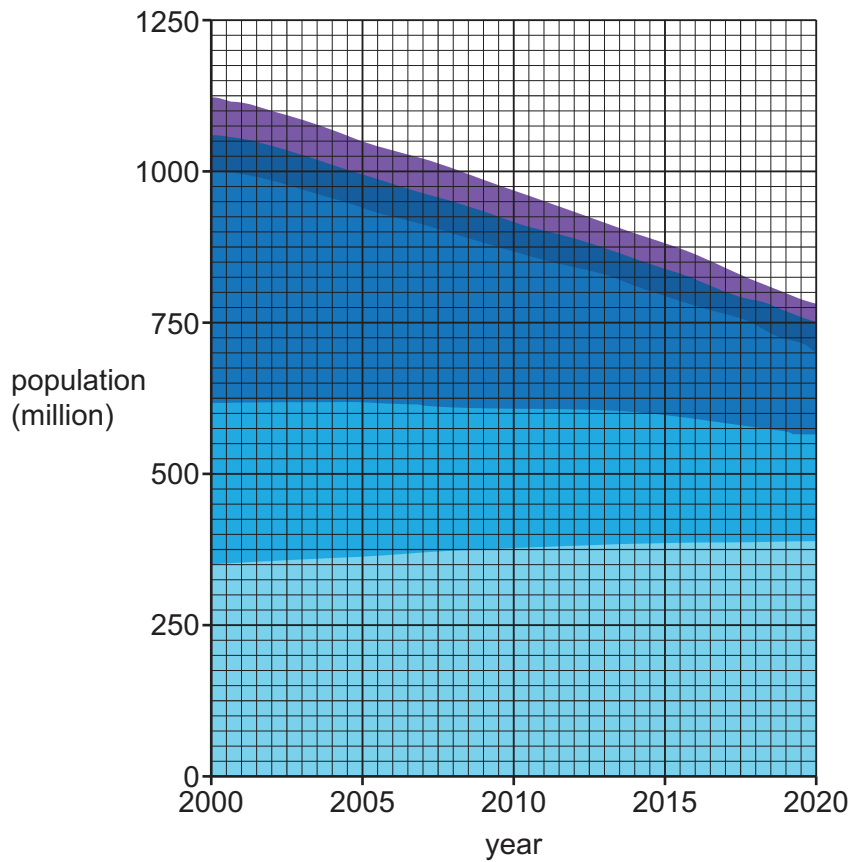

Population without basic drinking water services*, by world region, 2000–20

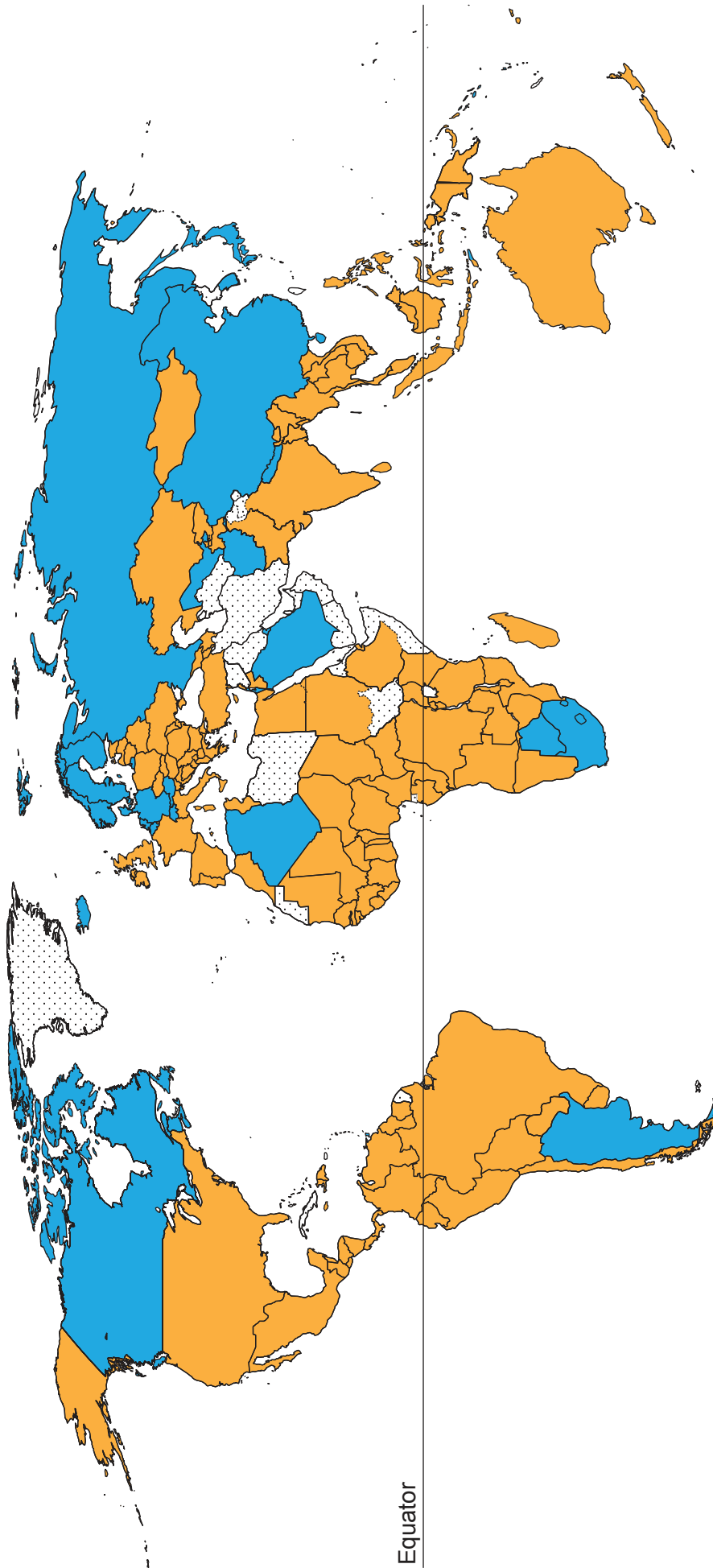
**Key**

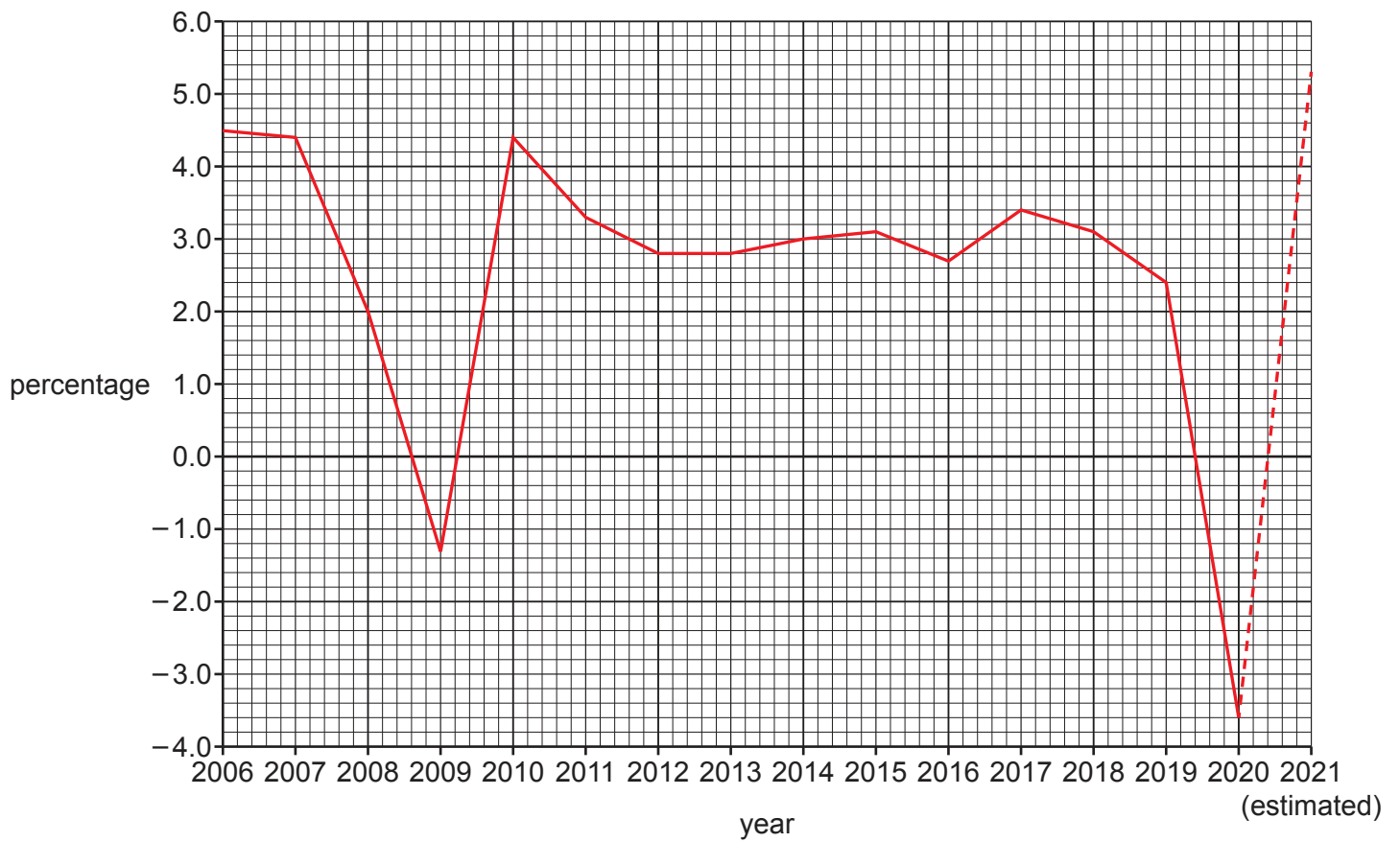

* Real GDP is the value of goods and services produced taking into account changing prices to remove the effect of rising prices over time (otherwise known as 'inflation').

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
