## Flows and stores of water in a drainage basin

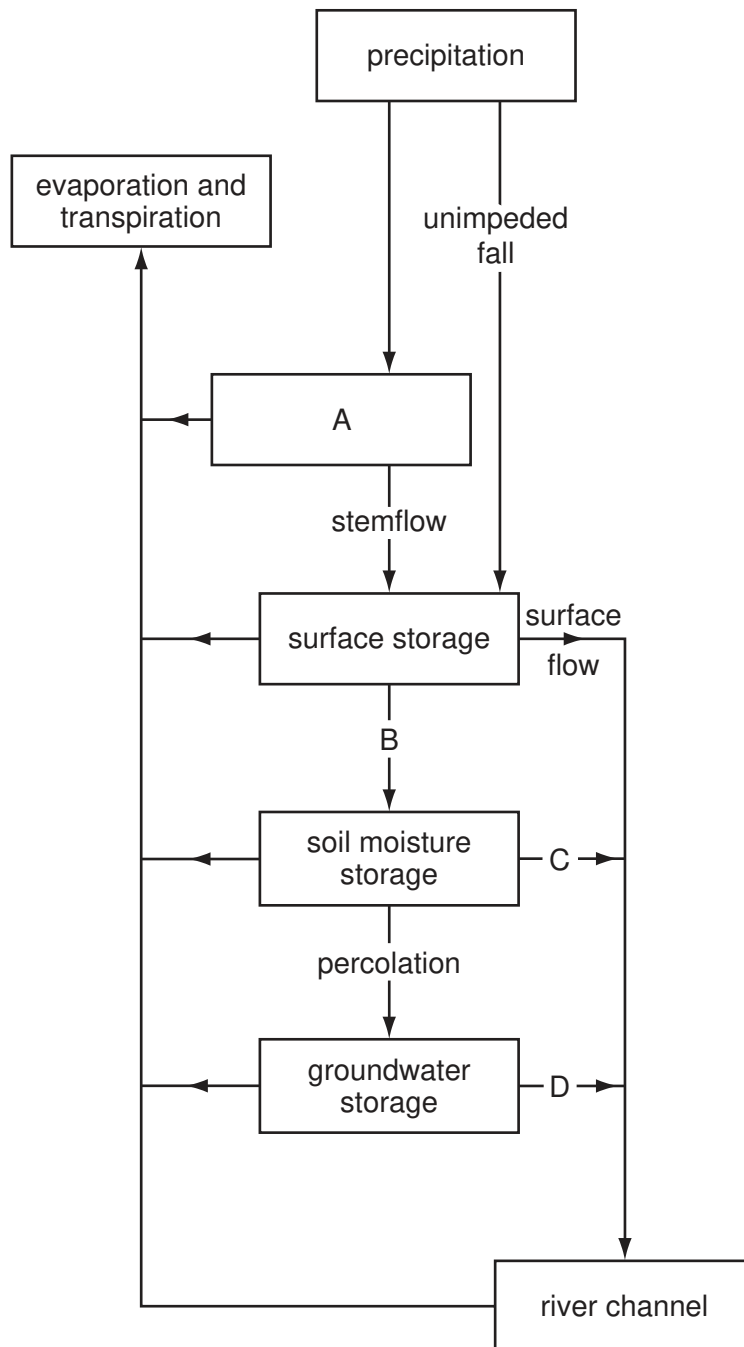

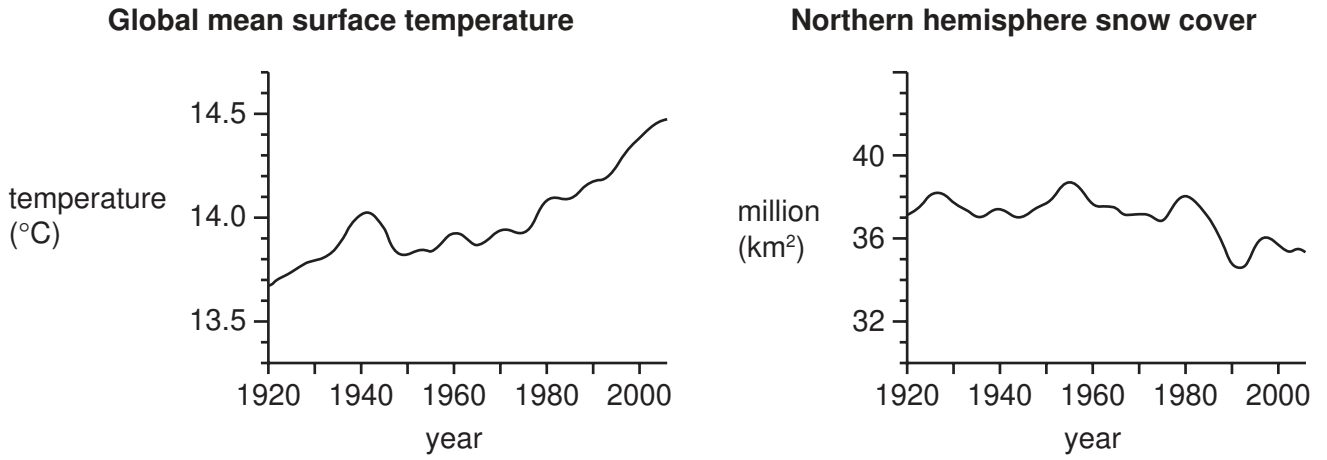
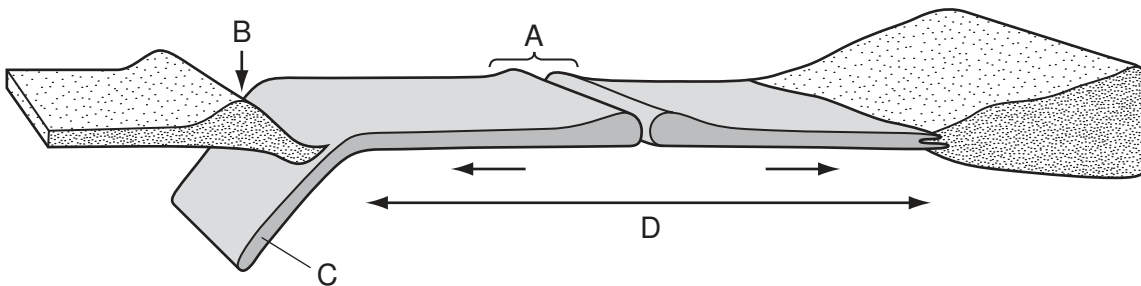


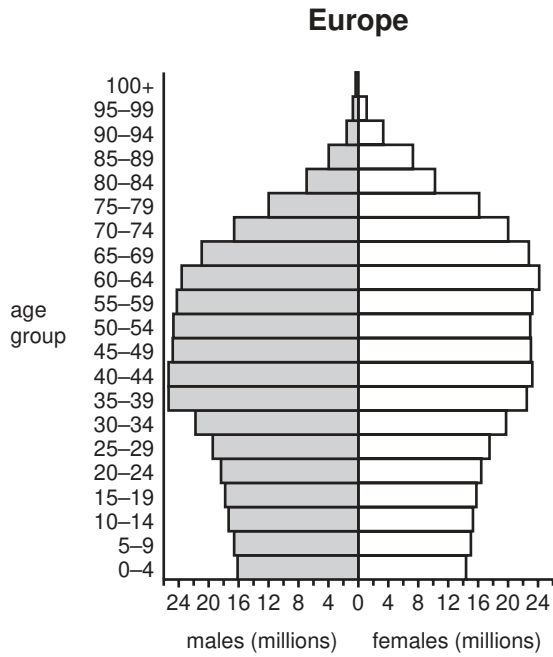

Some features associated with plate tectonics

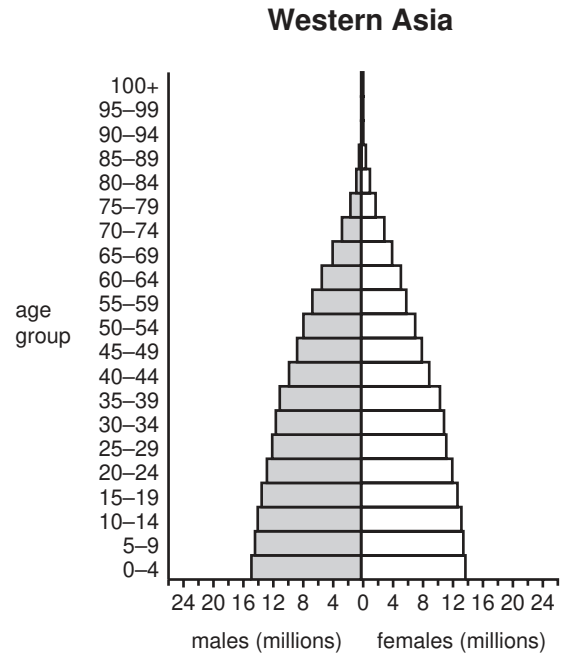


**Figs 4A, 4B and 4C for Question 4**

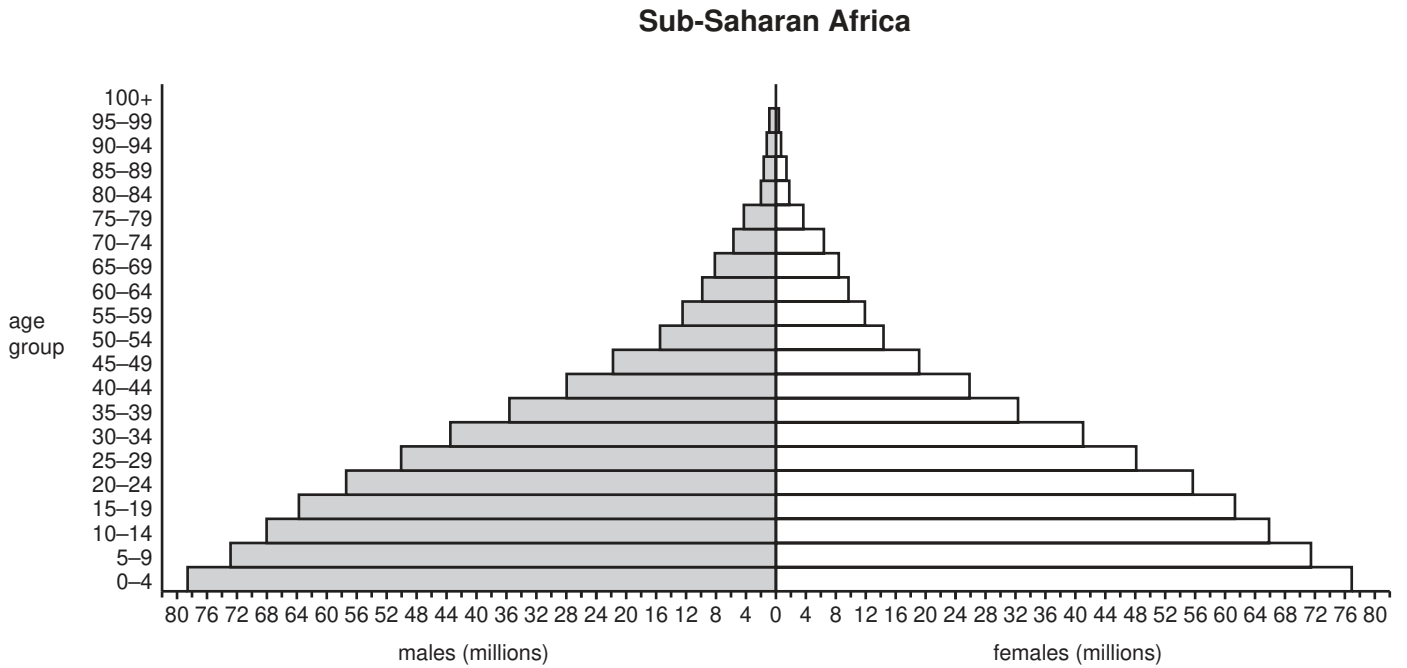
**Predicted age/sex pyramids for selected world regions in 2025**

## Christmas Island shipwreck kills asylum seekers

### 42 drown trying to reach Australia

Australia has seen an increase this year in asylum seekers arriving by boat. Today's incident, in which 42 people drowned when their boat smashed against rocks in a storm, shows the dangers involved in these journeys.

There are currently almost 3000 people in the Christmas Island Immigration Detention Centre waiting for officials to rule on their cases.

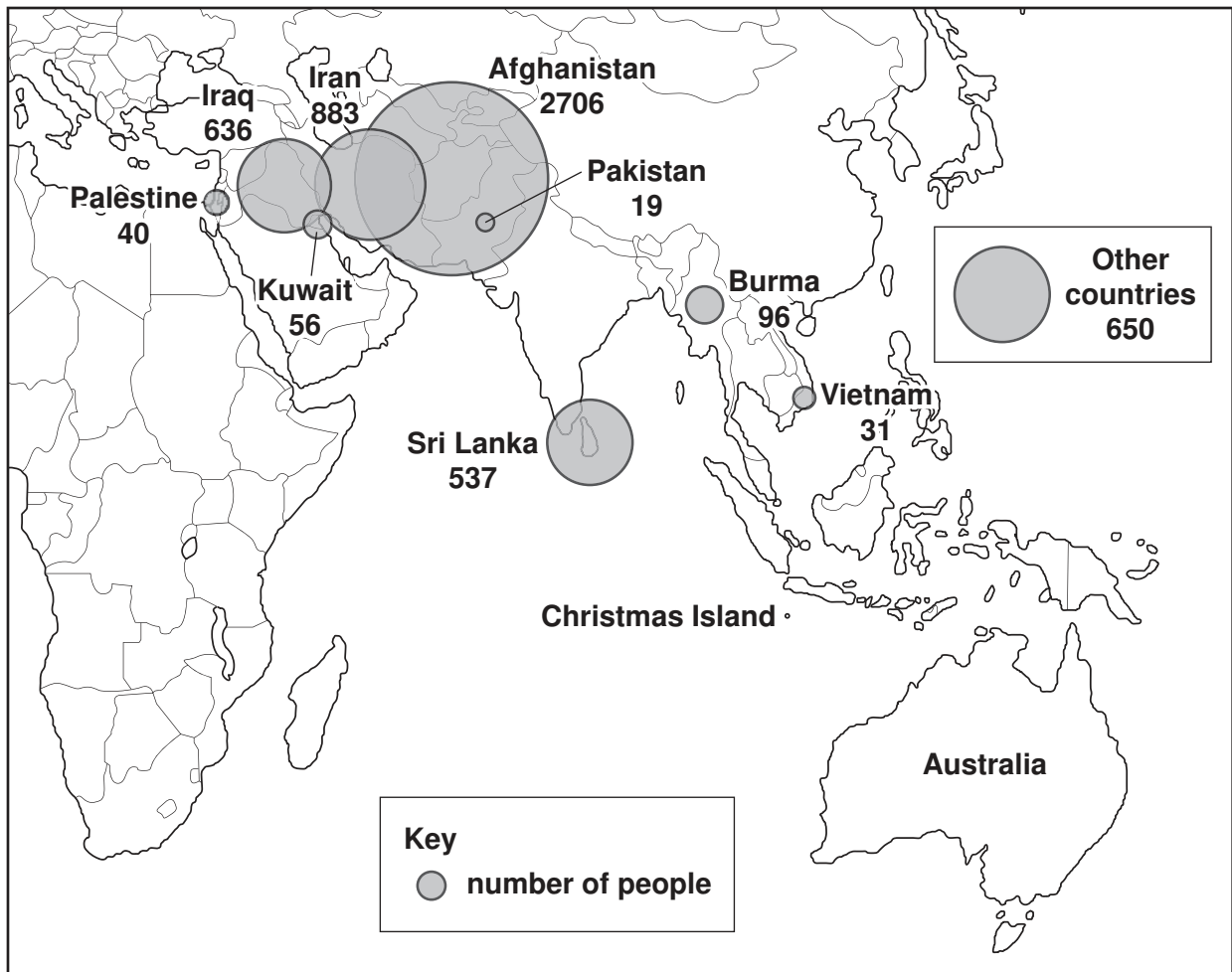
