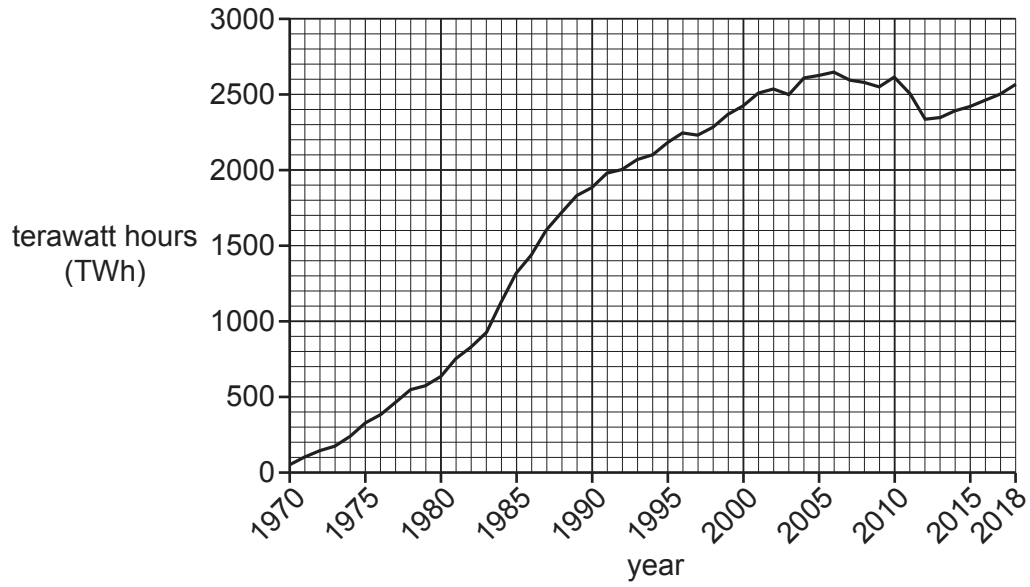

Selected trade agreements in Africa, 2020

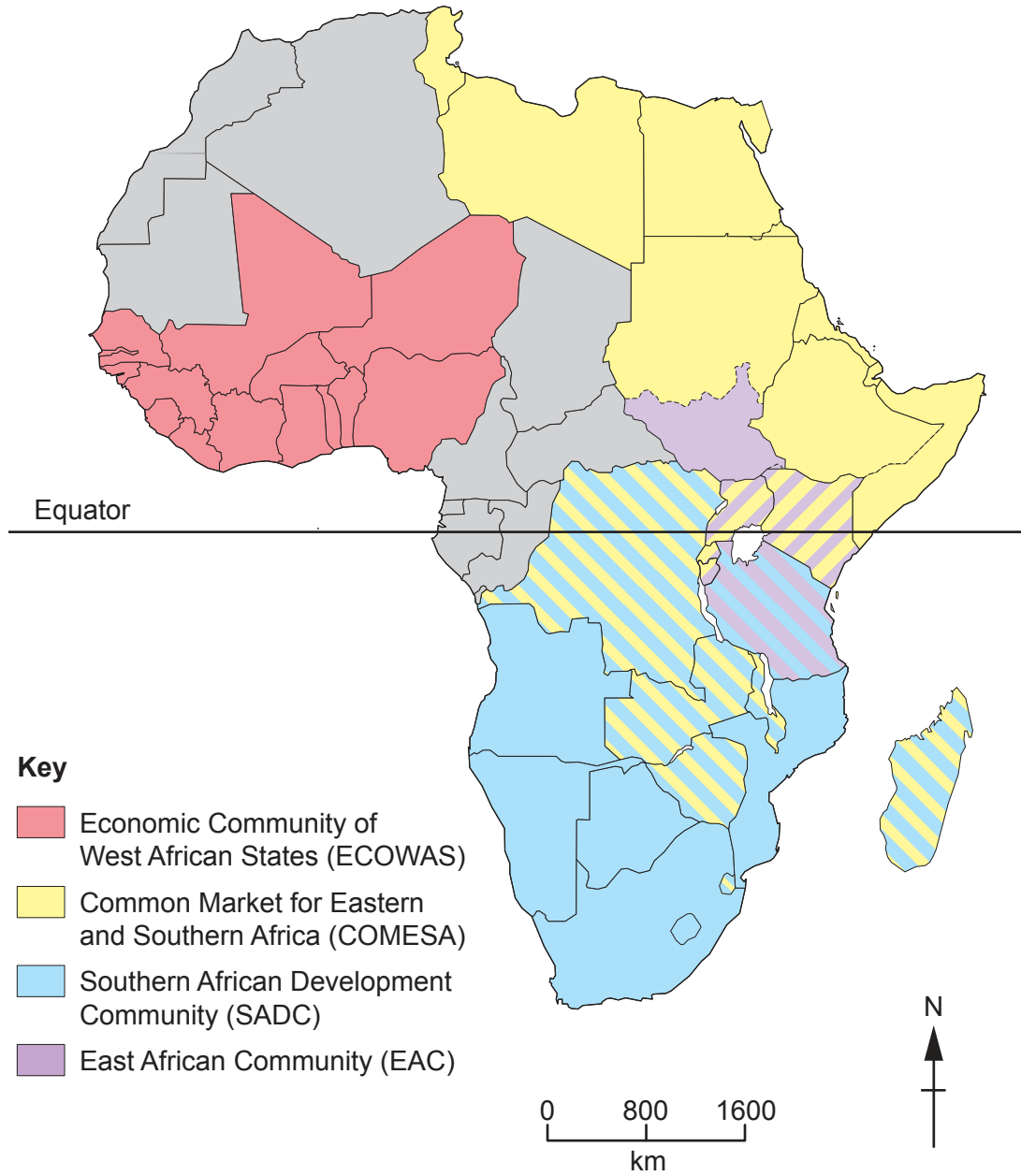

The countries of Africa

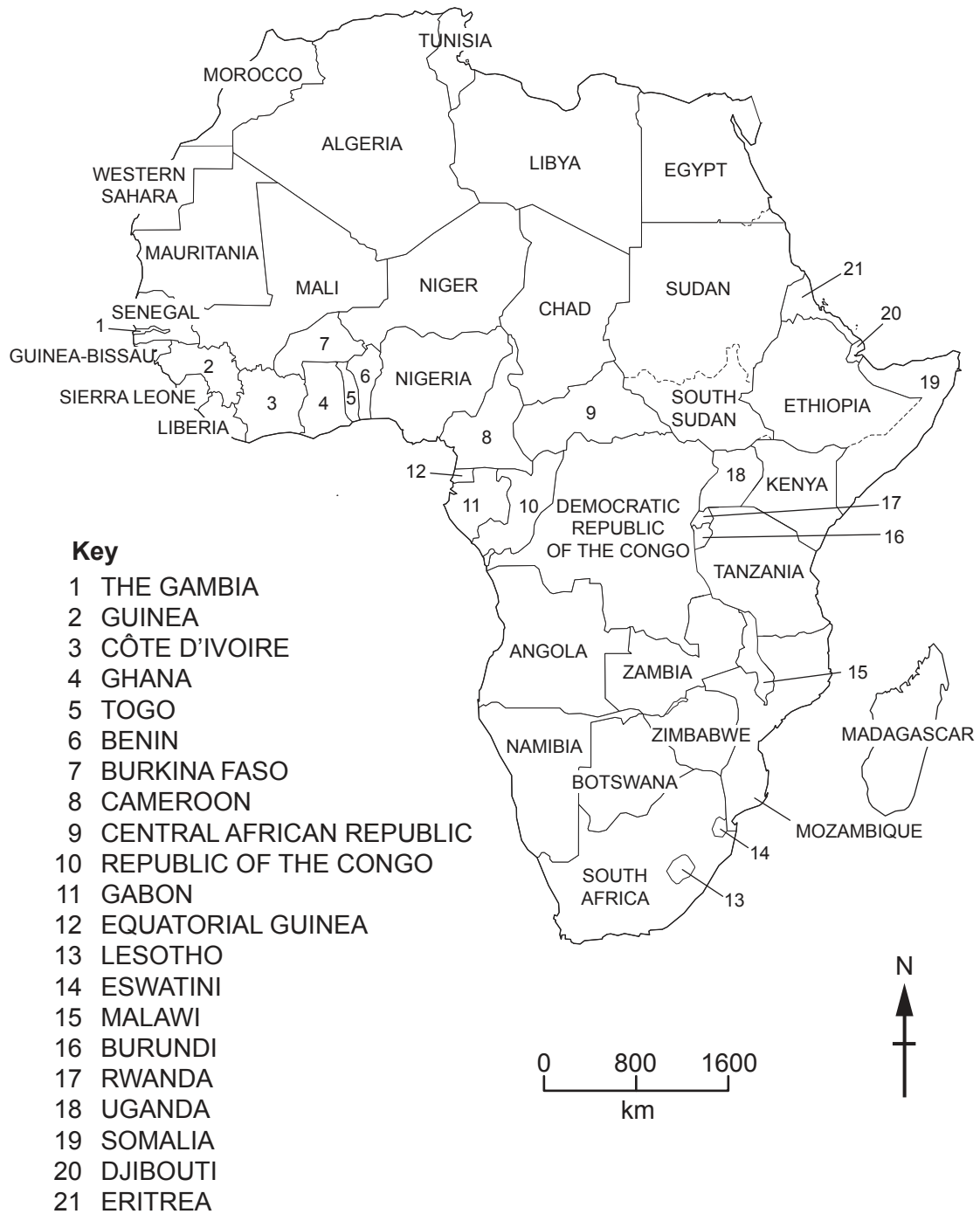
