Section A: European history in the interwar years, 1919–41

- 1 'Mussolini's policies towards women had only a limited impact on their lives.' Discuss this view. [30]
- 2 Analyse the impact of Stalin's policies towards non-Russian nationalities in the years 1928–41. [30]
- 3 'Hitler was appointed as Chancellor in Germany in 1933 because of the unpopularity of the Weimar government.' Assess this view. [30]
- 4 Analyse the extent of support for pacifism in Britain in the period 1934–39. [30]

Section B: The USA, 1944–92

- 5 Assess the extent of social mobility in US society in the late 1940s and 1950s. [30]
- 6 'Little was achieved in domestic policy during Nixon's presidency.' Discuss. [30]
- 7 Assess the reasons why gender inequality was a significant issue in the 1980s and early 1990s. [30]
- 8 'The US withdrew from Vietnam for political reasons rather than because of military failure.' Evaluate this view. [30]

Section C: International history, 1945–92

- 9** 'The growth of nationalism in the Soviet republics was the main reason for the collapse of the USSR.' Discuss this view. [30]
- 10** Evaluate the extent to which the USSR was responsible for the Sino–Soviet split. [30]
- 11** 'Superpower rivalry was the main reason for conflict in Ethiopia between 1950 and 1991.' Discuss this view. [30]
- 12** 'Oil was the main reason for US involvement in the Middle East in the period 1948–91.' Evaluate this view. [30]

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
