Vegan Veg (VV)

Jemi has always wanted to own a business. She is planning to buy a franchise called VV, a restaurant brand that only serves vegan meals. The meals do not contain any ingredients made from animal products. Market segmentation is important to VV. There has been an increasing trend for people to eat vegan meals.

Jemi will need to decide the best location for her restaurant. There are three possible locations outlined in Appendix 2. The restaurant will serve a wide range of vegan meals and Jemi will purchase ingredients, including fruit and vegetables, directly from local suppliers.

Jemi will employ a chef to cook the meals. The chef will be expected to work 40 hours a week. Jemi has identified the two best applicants. Their details are shown in Appendix 1.

As well as a chef, Jemi plans to employ another 3 people to help in the kitchen and 8 people to serve customers in the restaurant. Jemi knows that keeping these employees motivated will be important. She is considering using job enrichment or giving a discount on meals in the restaurant to keep her employees motivated.

Jemi is going to use her own capital of \$50 000 to buy the franchise, but she will also need a source of external finance to help set up the business. Jemi knows that the profitability and liquidity ratios for her restaurant will be important for the success of her business.

A recent government report said that everyone should be eating more fruit and vegetables. It found that this is particularly important to help keep children healthy and to live a long life. Eating less meat is also good for the environment.

Five years ago, only 10% of the population ate vegan meals but this percentage has increased to 25%. It is forecast that this trend will continue.

Many well-known restaurants are adding vegan meals to their menus. There are also new vegan restaurants being opened. However, it is getting more difficult to find reliable suppliers of fruit and vegetables. Restaurants are now having to buy from suppliers that are further away.
