**Grade thresholds** taken for Syllabus 0455 (Economics) in the October/November 2008 examination.

| Component 6 | 40                     | 27                               | 17 | 11 | 9   |

The threshold (minimum mark) for B is set halfway between those for Grades A and C. The threshold (minimum mark) for D is set halfway between those for Grades C and E. The threshold (minimum mark) for G is set as many marks below the F threshold as the E threshold is above it.

Grade A\* does not exist at the level of an individual component.
