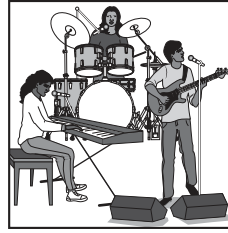

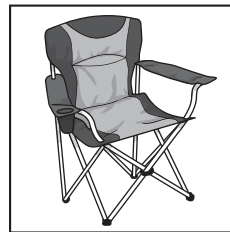

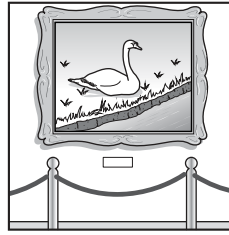
Which is the woman's favourite photo?



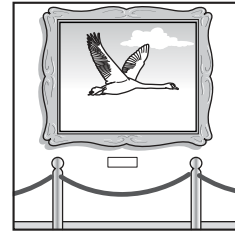
