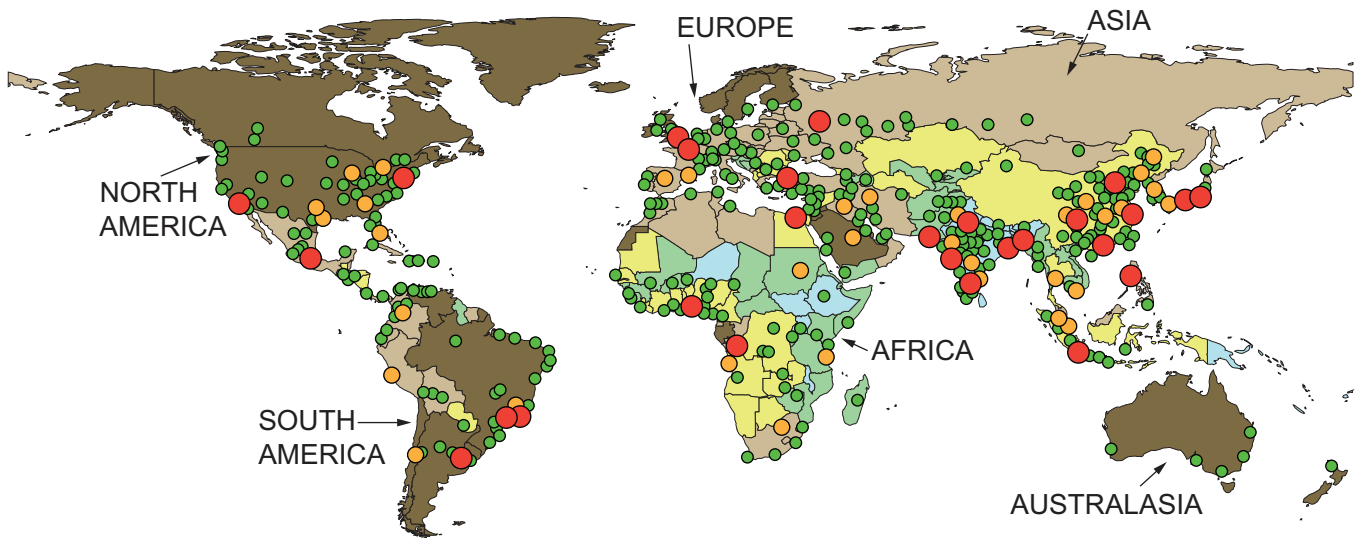
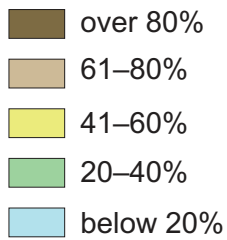


Fig. 2.1 for Question 2

population of city

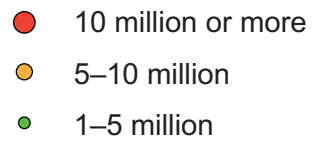

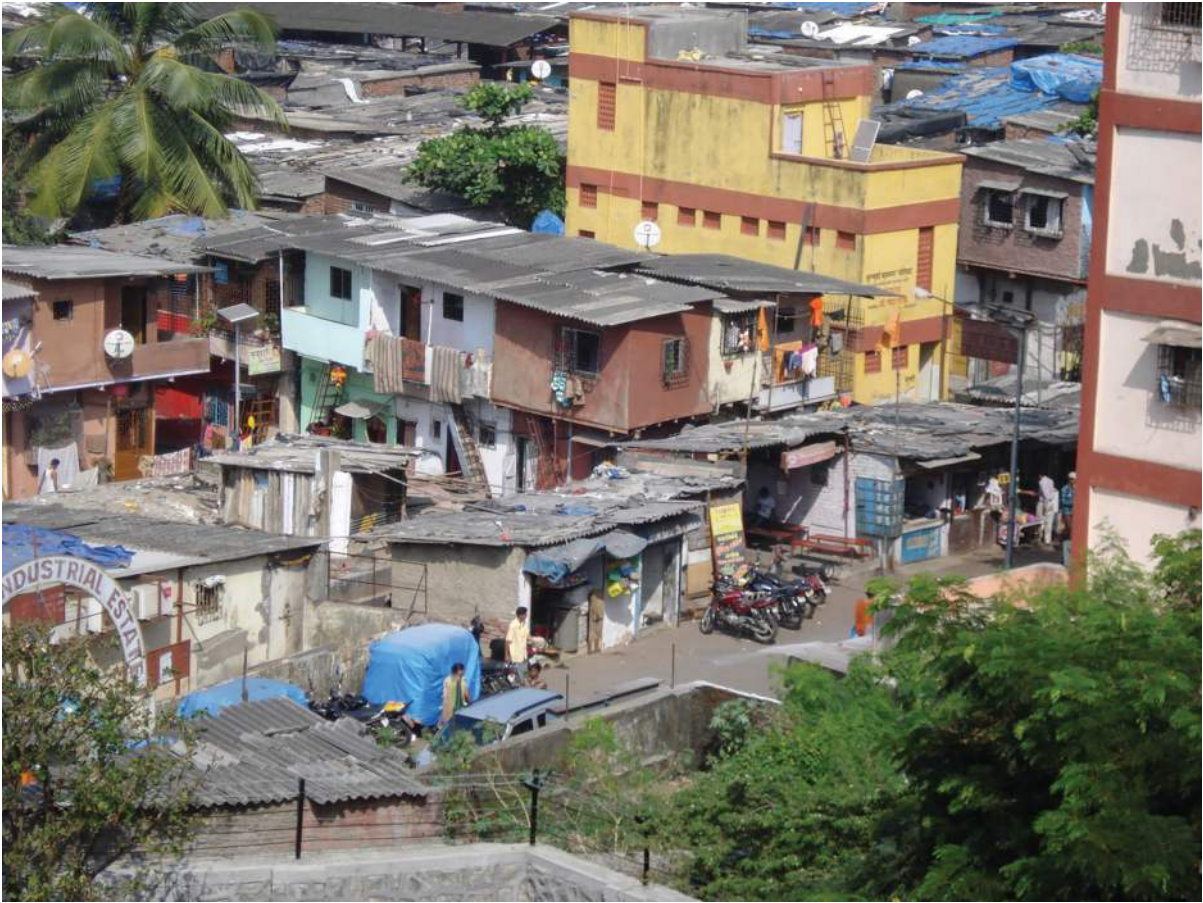
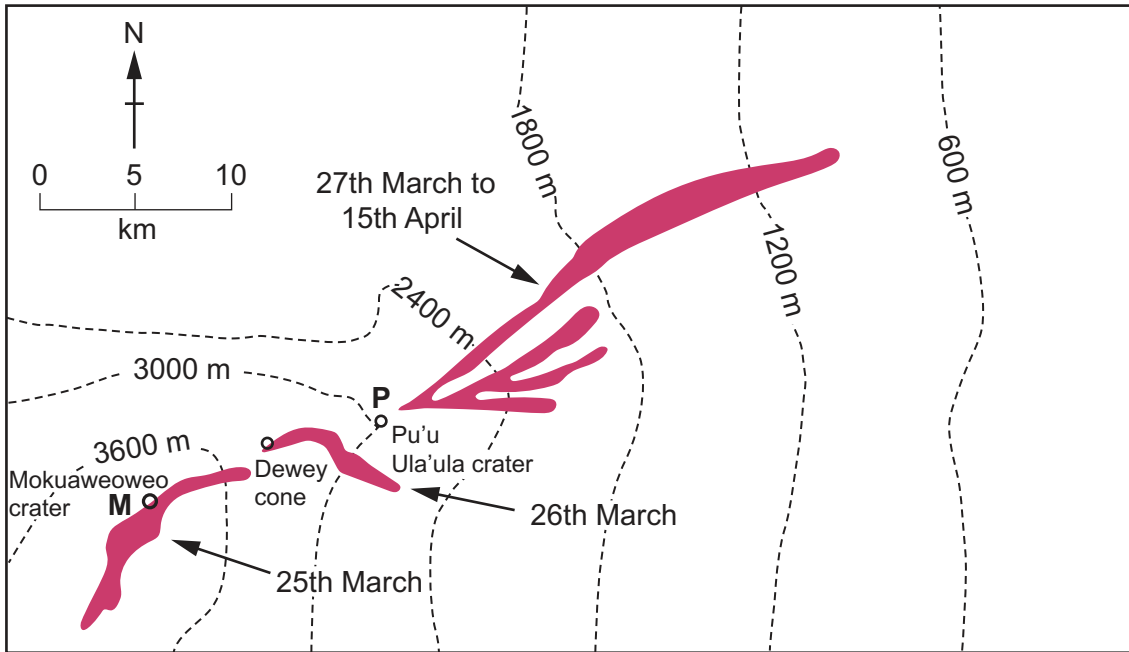

Eruption of Mauna Loa



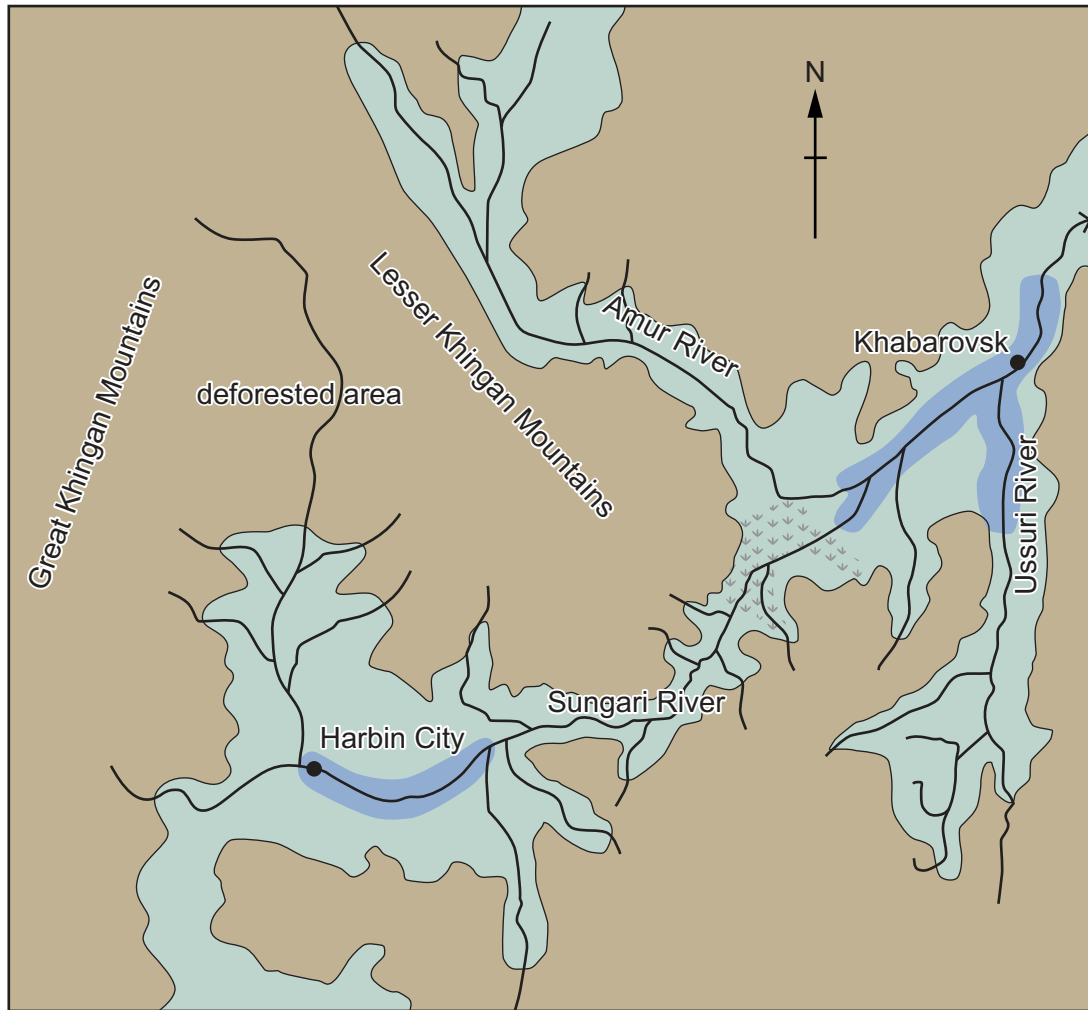

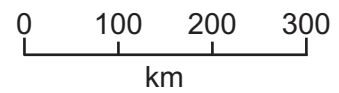
