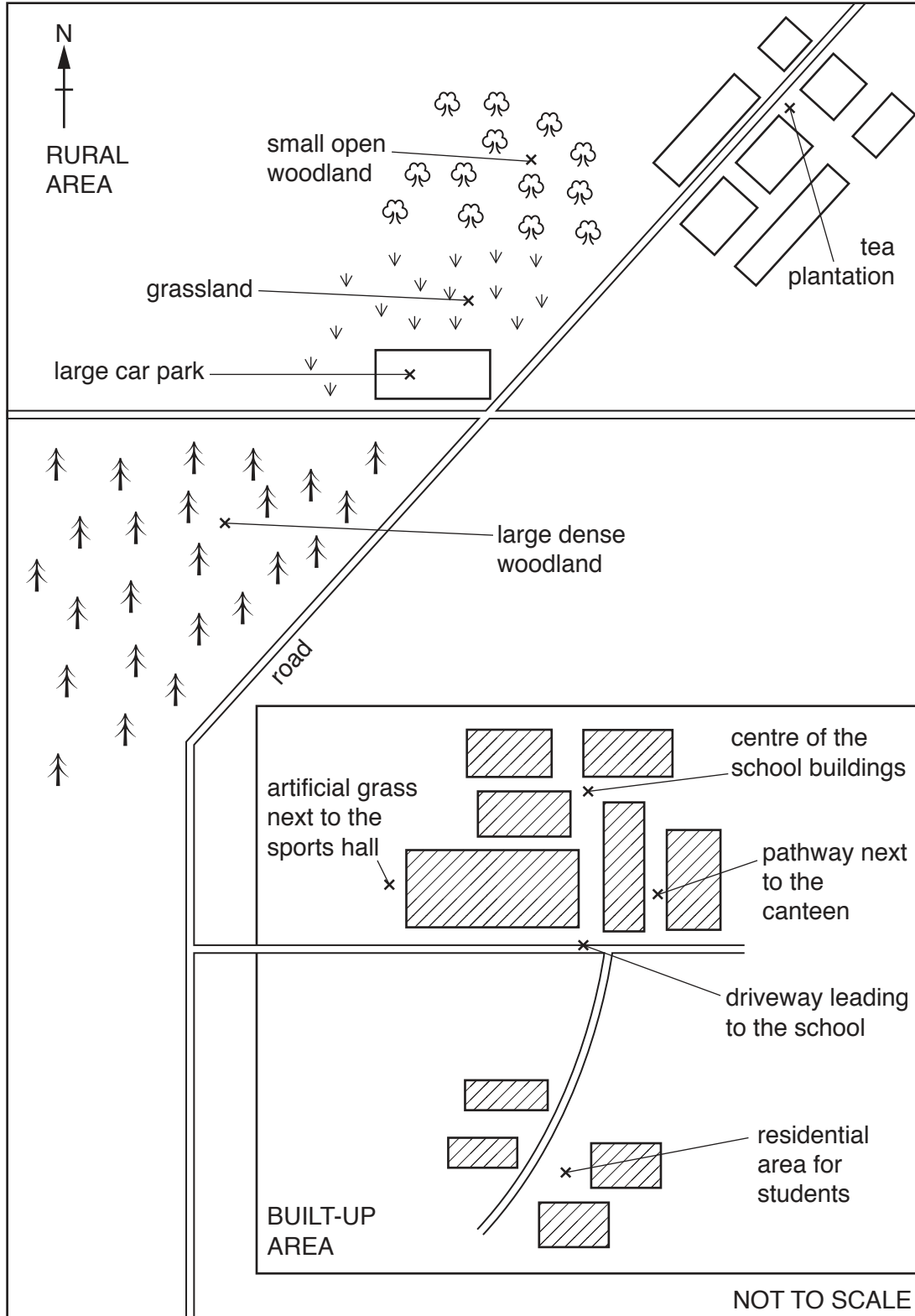


Fig. 1.1 for Question 1
