**International tourism**

According to the United Nations World Tourism Organisation (UNWTO), international tourism arrivals fell by 72% in 2021 compared with the pre-global pandemic year of 2019.

The travel and tourism industry is known as being resilient and dynamic. Despite the ongoing global pandemic there is evidence of the industry recovering.

In 2021 international arrivals increased by 4% which is 15 million more visitors than 2020. The average international tourist spend increased to \$1500 in 2021, an increase from \$1300 in 2020.

UNWTO have estimated that the direct global contribution of tourism in 2021 was \$1.9 trillion, an increase from 2020, but still below the pre-global pandemic levels when it was at \$3.5 trillion.

However, the rate of recovery is not the same across all regions of the world.
