Task

Cover all three points above **in detail**. You should make sure your letter is polite and informative. Start your letter 'Dear Parents,' and remember to add an appropriate ending.

At the head of your essay put the number of the topic you have chosen.

You are advised to write between 350 and 500 words. Total marks for this part: 30.

- 3 ‘All the problems in the world, large or small, are caused by selfishness.’ Do you agree? Give reasons and examples to support your view.
- 4 Write a story which includes the sentence: ‘Because of what I discovered, the return journey seemed a lot shorter and happier.’
- 5 Patience.
- 6 Write a story in which meeting a total stranger changed someone’s life.
