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General Marking Guidance

- All candidates must receive the same treatment. Examiners must mark the first candidate in exactly the same way as they mark the last.
- Mark schemes should be applied positively. Candidates must be rewarded for what they have shown they can do rather than penalised for omissions.
- Examiners should mark according to the mark scheme not according to their perception of where the grade boundaries may lie.
- There is no ceiling on achievement. All marks on the mark scheme should be used appropriately.
- All the marks on the mark scheme are designed to be awarded. Examiners should always award full marks if deserved, i.e. if the answer matches the mark scheme. Examiners should also be prepared to award zero marks if the candidate's response is not worthy of credit according to the mark scheme.
- Where some judgement is required, mark schemes will provide the principles by which marks will be awarded and exemplification may be limited.
- When examiners are in doubt regarding the application of the mark scheme to a candidate's response, the team leader must be consulted.
- Crossed out work should be marked UNLESS the candidate has replaced it with an alternative response.

Türkiye'nin insanları İstanbul'un tarihi ve coğrafi özelliklerinden dolayı kentin benzersiz bir maratonu hak ettiğine inandılar. Organizatörlerin, Türkiye'nin seçkin atletlerini etkinliğe davet etmeden önce, bölgede trafik sorunu yaratmayacak bir güzergah planlamaları gerekiyordu. Ekim 1979'da Boğaziçi Köprüsü, tarihinde ilk defa bir maratona şahit oldu.

İstanbul maratonunun en önemli özelliği dostluk ve barış mesajını yaymayı hedeflemesidir. Maraton, tek yarışta iki kıtayı da kapsamı bakımından dünyadaki tek güzergahtır.

2013'te kalabalık nedeniyle köprüde oluşan tehlikeli dengesizlikten dolayı, köprü üzerinde sadece profesyonel atletlerin koşmalarına izin verilmektedir.

Maratona kayıt yaptırabilmek için katılımcılar yarış günü en az 18 yaşında olmalıdırlar. Maratonun yanı sıra, on ve on beş kilometrelik yarışlar ve ayrıca rekabetçi olmayan, eğlence amaçlı halk koşusu yapılmaktadır. Herkesin katılmasını sağlamak için çeşitli kategoriler bulunmaktadır.

Maraton şehrin Asya yakasında, Birinci Boğaz Köprüsü'ne yakın bir noktadan başlamaktadır. Atletler, İstanbul'un muazzam manzarasının keyfini çıkararak köprüyü geçtikten sonra, Sultanahmet Cami önünde yarışmayı bitirirler.
