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2. Translate the following passage **into Urdu**.

A girl with confidence

At the age of just 14, Aziza hopes to spread her message of education and basic rights for Afghan youths. She has already overcome the legal obstacles preventing 25,000 refugee children from attending school. She has also made sure that the local authorities agree to provide tap water to her camp, which houses more than 100 families.

“These children are the product of war. They suffered a lot during the war years. I give them advice on the importance of education,” she said in Dari. “As our families are uneducated, we have to talk to them and convince them too”.

Aziza is facing a very difficult task. She is trying to persuade adults in a very conservative society to change their ways. Her confidence has impressed the representative of an international humanitarian agency. He commented that “she was very special from the beginning; she was thinking more than others and asking the right questions. Gradually, she has become the representative for all the other children”.

In the ‘shuras’, the local community meetings, Aziza quickly presented the pressing issues faced by the children in her camp, and others like that in Kabul. The most urgent issue among these was the lack of clean running water. This meant that children had to walk a long way to fetch water in heavy containers for their families. Thanks to Aziza, a water pipeline now brings clean water into the camp and serves all the families.

3. Translate the following passage into English.

A village with no roads

ہالینڈ میں ایک ایسا گاؤں ہے جس میں اپنے گھر سے کسی دوسرے کے گھر جانے کے لیے سڑکیں بالکل نہیں ہیں۔ اس گاؤں کے لوگ ایک دوسرے کے گھر آنے جانے یا شاپنگ پر جانے کے لیے وہاں کی خوبصورت نہروں میں چھوٹی کشتیاں استعمال کرتے ہیں یا پھر پیدل گھومتے ہیں کیونکہ ان نہروں کے اوپر لکڑی کے پل بنائے گئے ہیں۔ تمام کاروں کو گاؤں کے باہر ہی رکھا جاتا ہے۔ یہاں کے رہنے والوں کی زندگی کا یہ انداز صدیوں سے یونہی چلا آ رہا ہے اور سب لوگ اپنی اس سادہ زندگی سے بہت خوش ہیں۔ اس گاؤں کے چاروں طرف صرف ہریالی ہی ہریالی، خوبصورت گھر اور پانی نظر آتا ہے۔ یہاں پر موجود نہروں کی لمبائی چار میل ہے۔ اس گاؤں کے بہت سے فارم ہاؤس اٹھارویں صدی میں بنائے گئے تھے۔

شدید سردی کے موسم میں، جب نہروں میں پانی جم جاتا ہے تو پھر لوگ کشتیوں کے بجائے آئس سکیننگ کرتے نظر آتے ہیں۔

اس میں کوئی شک نہیں ہے کہ یہ گاؤں اپنے انوکھے پن، انفرادی خوبصورتی اور دلکشی کی وجہ سے دنیا بھر کے سیاحوں کی توجہ حاصل کیے ہوئے ہے۔ اسے نیدر لینڈ کا وینس بھی کہا جاتا ہے۔ سائیکل کی سواری اور کشتی رانی کے علاوہ سیاحوں کے لیے یہاں کی نہروں کے راستے 'گائیڈڈ ٹور' کا بھی انتظام ہے جس کے ذریعے اس گاؤں کی دیہاتی زندگی کی دلکشی اور سحر انگیزی کا اندازہ کیا جاسکتا ہے۔ یہ گاؤں اس وقت بہت مشہور ہوا جب ایک ڈچ فلمساز نے 1958 میں اس گاؤں کو اپنی فلم میں دکھایا۔
