- **4.** The mass media can function either as tools of revolution or of propaganda. Discuss with reference to your study of this option.

Future issues

5. In what ways may the future improve upon the past? Are there any ways it is unlikely to? Discuss, using specific examples from your study of this option.

Global issues

6. Identify two examples of recent global cooperation (*e.g.* political, environmental, cultural, or others) and explain why they were or were not effective.

Social issues

7. Social isolation affects many people and can lead to other social problems. Discuss with reference to your study of this option.

Literary questions

- 8. Works of literature can often function as social commentary. Discuss with reference to at least two literary works you have studied.
- **9.** Examine the portrayal of "difference" (*e.g.* physical limitations, mental illness, race, class, or sexual identity) in at least two literary works you have studied.
- **10.** Discuss the role of fear in at least two literary works you have studied.
