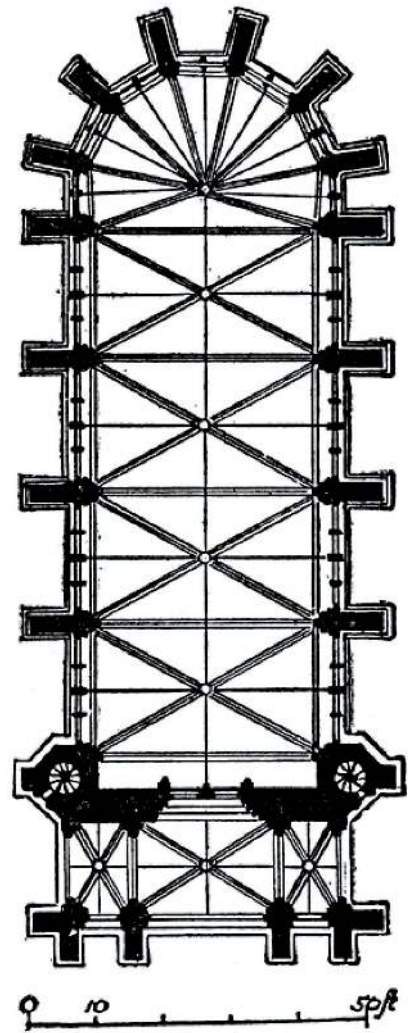
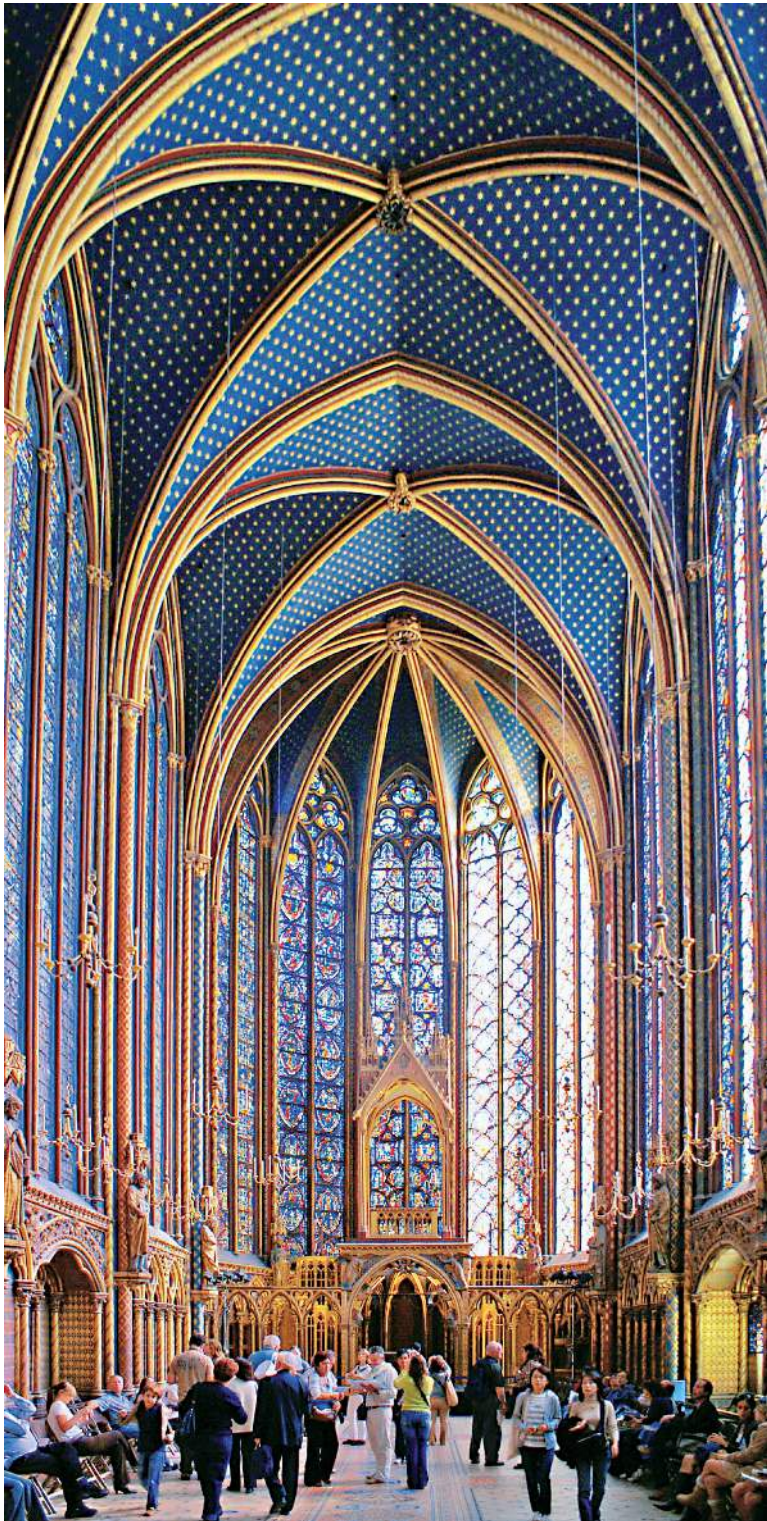
Topic 3 The Middle Ages
