- 2. Discuss the relationship between kinship and either gender or inequality.
- **3.** Examine how **either** colonialism **or** globalization has shaped **one** of the following:
 - human suffering
 - group identity
 - resistance
 - commodification.
- 4. Contrast socialization processes in **two** societies.
- **5.** Discuss the role of agency in economic organization.
- **6.** Examine the importance of ritual in political organization.
- 7. Examine the relationship between power and **either** migration **or** tourism.
- **8.** Examine the relationship between gender and division of labour.
- **9.** Discuss how modernity has affected local exchange systems.
- 10. Discuss how contact between different societies can result in new forms of **one** of the following:
 - inequality
 - social movements
 - systems of production and consumption
 - belief systems.
