- 5. Examine the relationship between political organization and **one** of the following:
 - urbanization
 - colonialism
 - globalization.
- 6. Examine the relationship between modernity and changes in belief systems and practices.
- 7. To what extent does ideology maintain power and authority?
- 8. Examine ways in which the environment becomes the focus of political organization.
- 9. Discuss how one of the following becomes the basis of identity formation:
 - age
 - sexuality
 - class
 - ethnicity
 - religion.
- 10. Discuss the importance of either human rights or cultural rights in the contemporary world.
