 2. With reference to post-conflict peacebuilding, analyse the statement “Stop the killing, we want to build a homeland for all Syrians.” (*Source B, line 5*). [4 marks]
 3. Compare and contrast the opinions expressed about the conflict in Syria in Source B and Source C. [4 marks]
 4. With reference to all four sources and drawing from your own knowledge, examine the extent to which the strategy and objectives of non-violent protest are different to those of violent protest. [8 marks]
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
