1. Discuss the impact of globalization on **one** of the following:

- systems of production
- gender relations
- religion.
- 2. Examine the relationship between political organization and **either** leadership **or** egalitarianism.
- 3. To what extent is agency constrained or enabled by social class?
- 4. Examine the importance of ideology in maintaining kinship systems.
- 5. Discuss power and resistance in **one** society or social group.
- 6. Examine the role of economic organization in **one** of the following:
 - migration
 - relationships with the environment
 - tourism.
- 7. Discuss what part modern technologies play in **either** indigenous movements **or** social movements.
- 8. Examine how **either** modernity **or** changes in consumption practices have shaped **one** of the following:
 - identity
 - sexuality
 - ethnicity.
- 9. To what extent do transformations of exchange systems alter either marriage or labour practices?
- **10.** Discuss the role of moral systems in relation to **one** of the following:
 - human rights
 - transnational systems of production
 - belief systems.
